HILO, HAWAII

“The Big Island” offers plenty of attractions from Punalu'u Black Sand Beach to the observatory on the peak of Mauna Kea. Other choices include Rainbow Falls, Liliuokalani Japanese Gardens and the active Kilauea caldera.

HONOLULU, HAWAII

Honolulu's glittering skyline stretches over iconic Waikiki Beach, bustling with energy, shops, restaurants and modern fun. Just outside of downtown, Diamond Head, palaces, gardens and Pearl Harbor pay tribute to the past.

NAWILIWILI, KUAUI

Natural splendors abound on Kauai, in addition to the many beaches, including Waimea Canyon, the “Grand Canyon of the Pacific,” the dramatic fluted cliffs of the NaPali Coast or the Kilauea Point Lighthouse, standing proud on the northernmost point in the Hawai'ian Islands.

TABUAERAN, FANNING ISLAND

Halfway between Hawaii and Tahiti, this tiny atoll is named “Footprint of the Gods” and is a paradise for snorkeling, diving and kayaking. A charming straw market features local handcrafts perfect for souvenirs.

NUKU'ALOFA, TONGA

Traditional culture comes alive in this capital region for the Tonga island chain with museums, artisan workshops and the nearby village of Mu'a where the impressive stone tombs honor Tongan kings of the past.

AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND

Auckland has harbors on two sides. Urban central Auckland covers a narrow isthmus between the Manukau Harbor on the Tasman Sea and the Waitemata Harbor on the Pacific Ocean.



SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

Beyond the iconic Opera House, Sydney is a fascinating mix of colonial charm and modern-day adventure. Don't miss snorkeling Gordon's Bay, climbing Harbour Bridge, the Taronga Zoo and aboriginal art at The National Park.

CAIRNS, AUSTRALIA

A sophisticated city flanked by primeval forests and broad golden beaches, Cairns is the gateway to the natural splendors of the Great Barrier Reef, the Kuranda Scenic Railway and the Daintree Rainforest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DARWIN, NORTHERN TERRITORY, AUSTRALIA

Despite its small size, Darwin is a modern, multi-cultural city, and its proximity to Asia makes it ideal for travel. Named after the famous scientist, Charles Darwin, it has a beautiful coastline, as well as numerous parks and gardens, making the city a top spot for outdoor activities.



MANILA, PHILIPPINES

The port of Manila is the largest and most important in the archipelago. The city of Manila proper, which boasts the densest population in the world, houses over 12 million people.

KEELUNG (TAIPEI), TAIWAN

As a unique culture shaped by native Taiwanese, Spanish, Dutch, and even British influences, the architecture, museums, shrines, temples and markets, from Qingyu Hall to Lukang Old Street are varied and one-of-a-kind.

Once the only Japanese port open to foreign trade, Nagasaki acquired a unique multicultural character. The Western-style homes on Dutch Slope housed early Dutch and European merchants. The city also boasts two Chinese-style Zen Buddhist temples and a still-active Chinatown.

"Paris of China" and "Pearl of the Orient," the vibrant city of Shanghai is a shining symbol of the economic emergence of the world's largest nation. A comfortable jumble of old and new.

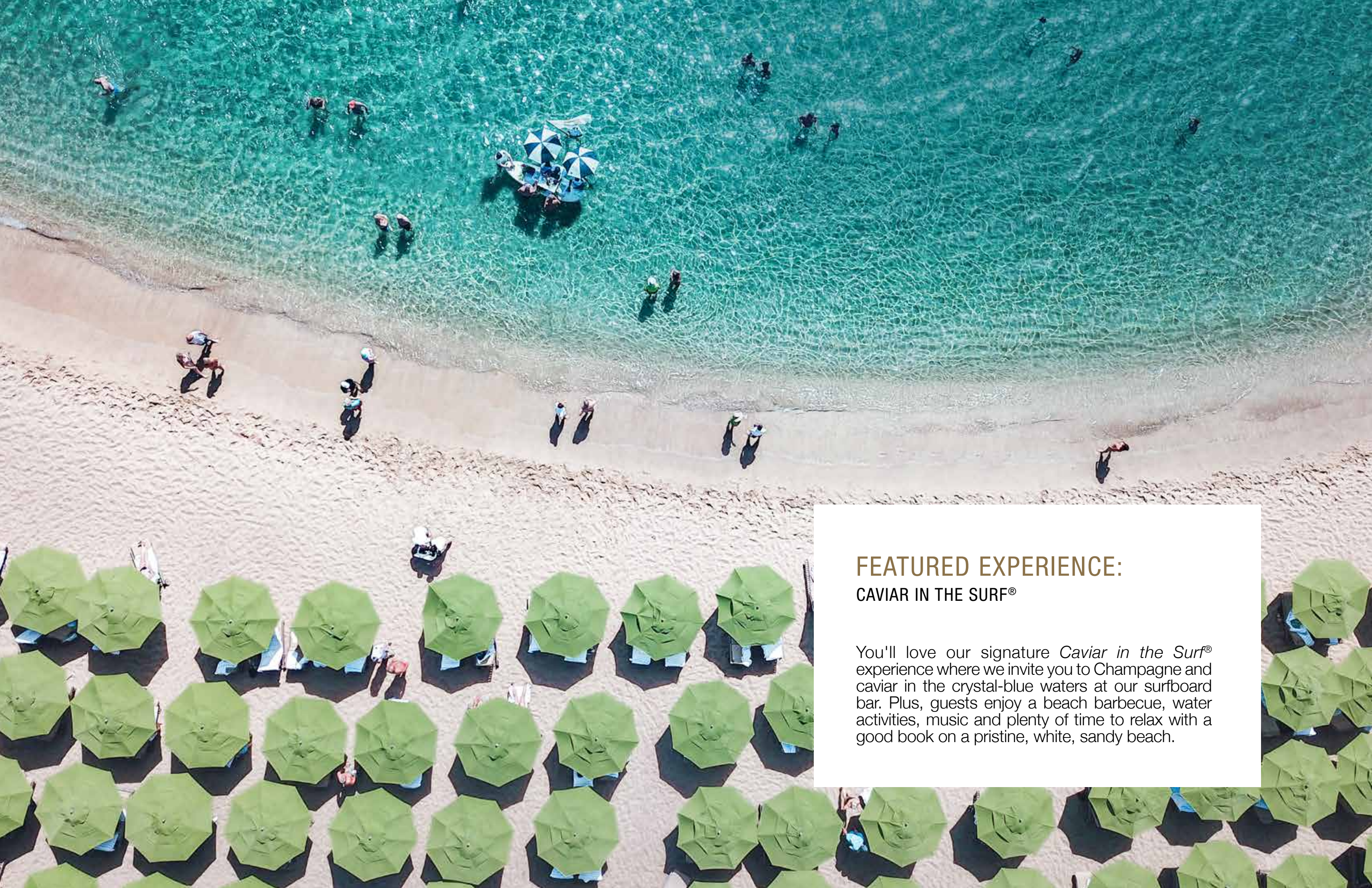
